

Worship Intern Position Description

This person will play a key role in the worship leadership of Emmanuel Covenant Church (ECC), with specific responsibilities and learning opportunities listed below. This person reports to the Lead Pastor and will work closely with the Worship Committee Chairperson. The worship intern work roughly 10 hours per week (specific schedule to be determined based on availability and church schedule).

Qualifications:

- Faith in Jesus Christ, and an understanding a comfort with the identity of our denominational family the Evangelical Covenant Church (covchurch.org)
- Musical competency in a lead instrument (guitar or piano) and voice
- · comfort in front of groups of people, leading in worship from the stage

Areas of Responsibility:

- Worship Team practices (beyond Sunday morning)
- Sunday morning worship team rehearsals
- Worship Service Planning
 - in partnership with the Lead Pastor and Worship Committee
- · Participating in and Leading Sunday morning worship services
- Attending Worship Committee Meetings
- Attending Worship Arts Committee Meetings
- Developing one-on-one mentoring relationships with members of the worship teams (and potential team members) for:
 - musical development
 - discipleship
- Some administrative work specific to the worship life of ECC
- Other worship specific duties to be determined by the lead pastor
